Please read this handout carefully

This handout contains the rules and behavioral expectations we have for both the Member and their dog.

Adherence to these rules is essential to the success of our dog park!

Rules

- Owners are responsible for the actions of their dogs
- Pay attention to your dog - A friendly dog may intimidate a more passive dog
- Be ready to call off your dog if it becomes too pushy
- Your dog must be under your voice control at all times
- You must stay at the Park with your dog
- Never leave a dog unattended
- Dogs must be on a leash when entering **and** exiting the Park
- NO Choke or Pinch collars left on during play
- Dogs must wear a collar with identification during every visit to the Park
- All dogs must be properly vaccinated
- **Always clean up after your dog !!**
- Limit three dogs per person
- You must fill any hole dug by your dog
- Puppies (under 4 months) are not allowed
- You must be ten (10) years of age or older to enter the Park
- Don't bring food into the Park
- Glass containers are prohibited
- Aggressive dogs are prohibited
- **NEVER** let a non-Member into the Park
- If you are a city resident your city tag is required
- Don't bring a female dog that is in heat, to the Park

We strongly encourage our members to spay / neuter their dogs

Please Note :

The Park is built on an old landfill; glass may surface periodically after rains, where grass is not established.

Members are encouraged to police the area and throw away anything undesirable that they may find.

Remember - The success of our Park depends on its Members

If the rules are followed, many problems will be prevented.

It is acceptable and encouraged that you politely remind fellow Members of the rules should you see the rules not being followed.

Persistent problems will result in a warning with mandatory education, and progress to fines or other penalties, and may lead to the revocation of your membership without a refund.

If a true emergency exists, don't hesitate to call 911

Liability Waiver/Hold Harmless Agreement

You must sign the **Liability Waiver/Hold Harmless Agreement** to become an EDOG Member.

It means that in using an off-leash area, you agree to waive or forfeit the right to sue or involve local bodies (City of Evansville, E.D.O.G. and the Parks Department) in the event you and/or your dog are injured.
